Michigan History Magazine was microfilmed by the University of Microfilms, Ann Arbor, Michigan, date unknown.

From 1917-1976, Michigan History Magazine was a smaller sized publication than it is as of this writing (in 2021), and was perfect bound (like a paperback book). The publication during this period resembles the current Michigan Historical Review. Beginning in 1977, Michigan History Magazine's format was enlarged and pages appeared about 8 and ½ by 11 inches in size, and were stapled. This same format continues today.

Initially in 1917, Michigan History Magazine was published by the Michigan Historical Commission. By the 1970s it was published by the Michigan Department of State.
