The *Michigan Statesman and St. Joseph's Chronicle* was the first newspaper published in Southwest Michigan when it was still a territory. Under the editorship of John D. Defrees, the first issue of the *Statesman* came off the press at White Pigeon, St. Joseph County in December 1833.

John Defrees continued as editor of the *Michigan Statesman* until the third week of June 1834. All issues of the *Statesman* under Defrees' editorship are missing.

On June 28, 1834 Henry Gilbert assumed the role of editor. Fortunately for history, most issues of the *Statesman* dating from 1834-1836 survive, containing valuable historical information regarding the regions early development.

Gilbert operated the newspaper out of White Pigeon until September 17, 1835. After that he moved north to the village of Bronson, Kalamazoo County. In March 1836 the village name of Bronson was changed to Kalamazoo. Beginning in January 1837 Henry Gilbert changed the name of his paper to the *Kalamazoo Gazette*. As of this writing (May 2023), the *Kalamazoo Gazette* is still published and remains one of the oldest continuously published newspapers in Michigan.

Below is a detailed index of the issues of the *Michigan Statesman and St. Joseph's Chronicle* contained on a single roll of microfilm at the Local History Branch of the Cass District Library. The master reel is archived the Library of Michigan in Lansing.
