



Howard Township Seeks Resident to Complete 2026 Library Board Term

Howard Township is seeking interested residents to serve as its appointed representative on the **Cass District Library Board (CDL) of Trustees**, filling a recently created vacancy. The selected individual will complete the remainder of the four-year term, which expires December 31, 2026, with the opportunity to renew through 2030.

The Cass District Library Board provides strategic leadership, fiscal oversight, and policy direction for a five-branch district library serving Cass County, MI. Trustees play a vital role in ensuring strong governance, community accountability, and support for the Library Director and staff.

CDL's legal service area includes the Cass County townships of Calvin, Howard, Jefferson, LaGrange, Mason, Milton, Newberg, Ontwa, Penn, Pokagon, Porter, and Volinia. Branches are located in Cassopolis, Edwardsburg, Howard, and Mason-Union. CDL serves an overall population of over 38,000 residents in 12 Townships. The Library operates five branches totalling 35,923 square feet of occupiable building space for residents and users.
